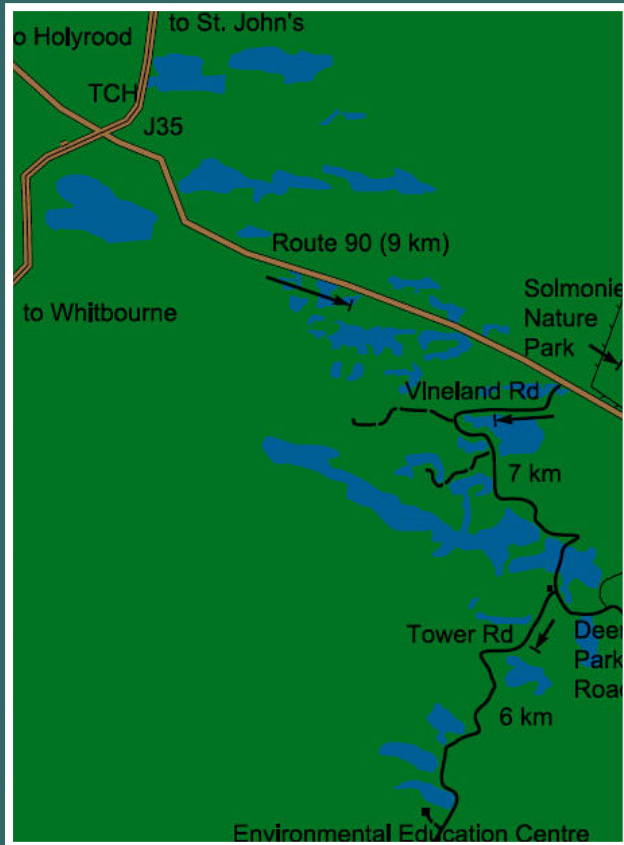

Fondly known as 'The Brother Brennan Centre' to thousands of Newfoundland school children, the Environmental Education Centre is a residential outdoor school dedicated to helping students learn about the environment. It is also a perfect destination for family reunions, retreats, artistic workshops, youth camps or simple relaxation. The centre is located in a tranquil, wilderness setting on the Avalon Peninsula only one and a quarter hours from the city of St. John's, Newfoundland, Canada.

Designed to help students become more aware of their environment and to enhance personal and social responsibility for environmental action, the Environmental Education Centre is the ideal setting for outdoor education.

Students are totally immersed in environmental education during an intensive 1 night/2 day program. Experiential programs are cross-curricular and focus on ecological principals and concepts and also allow time for activities such as hiking, a campfire, folklore, orienteering and community building.

Programming is available from mid-September until the end of November and again in May and June. Curriculum based environmental education programs are developed, booked and implemented by District School in the Eastern School District. Rentals are available to public and private groups/organizations who are committed to an environmentally responsible wilderness experience.

Meals and Accommodations (per night)

Includes bed, three meals and two snacks per day.

\$430 + \$45 per person

Accommodations Only (per night meals not provided)

Includes bed, and access to kitchen facilities.

\$300 + \$15 per person

Youth Group Camping (per night)

Includes access to outdoor classroom and A-frame cabin.

\$180 + \$5 per person

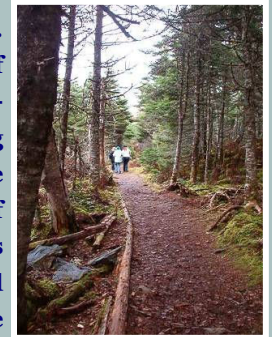
The Environmental Education Centre is a practical, four building facility that offers:



- Heated sleeping accommodations for up to 70 people. Most rooms accommodate 6 people in bunks. Mattresses are provided, but visitors bring their own bedding. There is also an observatory, ideal for observing the night sky.
- Shared washrooms with showers
- Modern, fully equipped commercial kitchen
- Dining room capable of seating 70 with woodstove
- Large modern classroom
- A small classroom
- Outdoor classroom with woodstove
- An A-frame cabin with woodstove
- Large patios with a barbeque
- Campfire pit

Eight kilometer of well maintained trails make the Environmental Education Centre, ideal for walking, snowshoeing or x-country skiing. There are lots of quiet places perfect for relaxing and enjoying the tranquility of Newfoundland's woods, bogs and ponds. The Centre is located on Father Shea's Pond, where visitors enjoy swimming, fishing (in season) and canoeing.



For canoeists Father Shea's pond is part of a network of ponds leading out to Lockyer's Pond.
